UNIFORM

We are a uniform academy and request you support us in this by sending your child to school in full uniform each day.

Our uniform consists of:

Red or white polo shirt

Red sweatshirt, hoodie or cardigan

Black/ charcoal trousers or skirt

Optional red dress for summer

Children should wear black shoes.

Jewellery is limited to one pair of stud earrings and a watch. Nose studs, necklaces or bracelets are not to be worn for safety reasons and all items of jewellery must be removed for PE lessons.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if my child is absent?

We ask that parents and carers contact us as soon as possible to inform us of their children's absence, using 'Option 1' on our answering service. In cases when we are unsure why a child is absent we will make contact ourselves in order to ensure children are safe.

Can we take a short holiday in term time?

Unfortunately you are not able to take holidays during term time and these will not be authorised. The Headteacher may authorise absences in exceptional circumstances such as religious reasons. A separate leaflet is available from the carousel in the entrance hall.

Why do we need to apply for 'free school meals' when younger children get a free meal anyway?

This can be a very confusing area as there are two schemes administered by Central Government. Every child in Years 1 already receives a 'Universal Free Meal', meaning they can have a meal at lunchtime in school for no cost. You do not have to apply for this, it is an automatic entitlement.

However, families with low income can apply for 'Free School Meals'. This will not only provide children of any age with a free meal, but we also receive funding to help those children with trips, visits and additional tuition if they are under achieving.

Can I come in and help?

Yes of course you can! We have a lot of parent volunteers, some working within their child's class and others preferring not to. All helpers in school need to complete their DBS checks online before working with the children.
